...OR KNIT A PAIR OF FINGERLESS GLOVES

Along with the blanket project we also want to knit 56 pairs of fingerless gloves for the children (boys and girls) who come to the school to do paired reading.

The gloves are made as follows: Cast on 28 stitches, rib 5 rows, knit for 10cm's (any pattern or stripes - see bottom left), knit garter stitch for 5 rows and cast off. Sew together leaving a hole for the thumb.
