SWIMMING SUCCESS

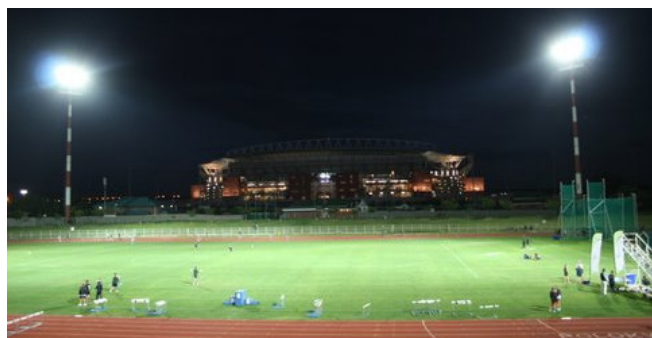

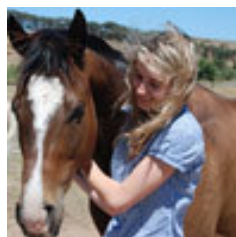
