**Tarryn Brent** cycled the "Makhulu 5" in Polokwane on Saturday, 13 February. She finished Second Lady overall.

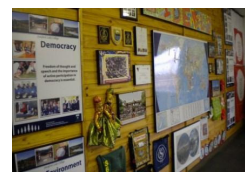
### SLC Grassland Rehabilitation Project (SLC Go Green) Update: February 2010.

It's midsummer and the SLC "Go Green" Project is in full swing. You will see SLC "GO Green" flags, and 2 new billboards, on the embankments on campus that were earmarked to be rehabilitated to the indigenous grasslands which used to grow in the area before the hotel and school were built. The rehabilitation of these embankments is progressing well, with all previously exposed areas recovering and returning to their former natural state. At this stage these embankments might appear to be scruffy and unsightly. However, that is how nature progresses and we are moving towards a new, better looking and environmentally friendly campus. This project will result in an increase in indigenous plant and animal life on the school campus within the near future. The grasslands will also help with environmental issues facing the school such as soil erosion, and water runoff and localized flooding.
